Control Cubes and Processes:

The maintenance and administration of a TM1 environment can range from an simple self-managing system to a complex nightmare of manual steps. The use of control processes and cubes can greatly reduce the headaches caused in the processing of the data.

Security:

- Security within the TM1 environment has been around since the early days and is fairly robust. Within the later versions of the software there has been an increased integration with the Cognos security especially around the Cognos Express offerings)
- Picklists – the trap when using Picklist cubes in a secured environment
